
Around 28nm SW of Malabo Island




29.05.2024: 2110 UTC: Posn: 03:12N - 007:58E, Around 28nm SW of Malabo Island, Equatorial Guinea. About nine pirates boarded a general cargo ship underway. They escaped with stolen GMDSS equipment, ship provisions, crew personal effects and kidnapped the Master and Chief Engineer. Remaining crew sailed the vessel to a safe port.













## Analysis of the Incident


- ☐ Pattern Recognition
